FAQ

Q: Do I need university acceptance before submitting the TGS grant application?

A: No. You can apply before being accepted. If already accepted, you must defer your studies to the next academic year. However, university admission does not guarantee selection as a Fulbright candidate.

Q: If I graduated from a master's program abroad, do I still need to submit TOEFL or IELTS score?

A: Yes, TOEFL or IELTS is required for all non-native English speakers.

Q: Does having work experience make a candidate more competitive?

A: It depends on the program. If the program requires work experience, then yes, it is necessary.

Q: My GPA is below the requirement, but I have an excellent professional profile. Can I still apply?

A: No. All eligibility criteria, including GPA, must be met to apply.

The Fulbright Program, established by the U.S. government in 1945, promotes mutual understanding through educational exchanges in over 160 countries with more than 400,000 alumni around the world.

The Fulbright Thailand began in 1950 as a binational program with funding support from both governments and administered by the Thailand-United States Educational Foundation (TUSEF/Fulbright Thailand). The program offers 16 annual grants for graduate study, research, teaching, and professional development. Fulbright participants serve as cultural ambassadors, strengthening global networks and friendships.
