The Fulbright Program, founded in 1946, is a global academic exchange initiative of the U.S. government aimed at fostering mutual understanding and promoting friendly, peaceful relations between the United States and other nations. Partnering with over 160 countries, it offers a wide range of fellowships and scholarships. In 49 countries, including Thailand, independent binational Fulbright Commissions administer the Fulbright Program with support from local governments.

Eligibility

- Thai citizen, up to 55 years old
- Bachelor's degree from a Thai university
- 5+ years full-time in public service with demonstrated leadership or management responsibilities
- Proven professional achievements and leadership qualities
- Valid TOEFL iBT 71+, IELTS 6+, or Duolingo 110*
- Able to take leave from their home institutions

**Duolingo English Test scores are accepted for the application stage only. If you are shortlisted for the next stage, you will be required to submit an official score report from the TOEFL iBT, meeting the program's minimum requirement.*



Required Documents

- Official diplomas and transcripts of all post-secondary education
- Valid passport or national ID
- English proficiency score report
- 2 letters of recommendation, one from current employer (submitted online directly by recommenders)

Grant Benefits

- Monthly stipend
- Book and supplies allowance
- Tuition and fees
- English language training program, if applicable
- J-1 visa sponsorship
- Round-trip international economy airfare
- Accident and sickness insurance coverage
- Additional funds for field trips, conferences, and other program-related activities, subject to approval

Selection Criteria

- Strong dedication, proven achievements, and growth potential
- Field aligns with Thailand's priorities
- Currently employed with guaranteed reemployment after the fellowship
- Ability to serve as a cultural ambassador of Thailand
